Subject: Appointment as "Jr. Staff Nurse" in the Pay Scale of (5200-20200+2400) "Health & Medical Education Department", Division Cadre, Jammu in pursuance of Advertisement Notice No. 03 of 2014, under Item No 289.

Whereas against 441 posts of Jr. Staff Nurse referred to Service Selection Board, Service Selection Board advertised 161 posts of Junior Staff Nurse vide advertisement No. 03 of 2014 (Item No. 289);

Whereas as while the posts were referred, some Jr. Staff Nurse were engaged on academic arrangement under SRO-384 including Nancy Kumari Bhat, to overcome the shortage of man power;

Whereas after her engagement in year 2016, Nancy Kumari Bhat & Others filed a Writ Petition, SWP No. 2532/2016 in Hon'ble High Court whereunder interim Order was passed reproduced as under:

"Status Quo shall be maintained. It is made clear that in case the official respondents continue with the selection process, the same would not be finalized without the permission of the Court and would be subject to the outcome of the Writ Petition" on dated: 01-12-2016;

Whereas the select list for the Post of Jr. Staff Nurse was finalized and issued by SSB vide No: SSB/Secy/Sel/2016/2016/20287-93 dated: 18-11-2016 in reference to Advertisement No: 03 of 2014 under Item No. 289 which was endorsed to this office by Administrative Department vide No. ME/NG/44/2012 dated: 13-02-2017;

Whereas in the meantime some candidates who were selected by SSB against the post of Jr. Staff Nurse also approached Hon'ble High Court through SWP No: 1868/2017, MP No. 1/2017 titled "Aziya Waseem Bhatti V/s State & Others" & "SWP No.: 1625/2017 titled Vijay Mala & Ors v/s State & Ors in which Hon'ble High Court has passed the orders directing Principal, Govt. Medical College, Jammu to consider the cases of the petitioners for appointment to the post of Jr. Staff Nurses, Divisional Cadre, Jammu against reserved category in accordance with the rules and regulations applicable by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the writ petition;

Whereas the matter was considered and it was felt that large No. of posts of Jr. Staff Nurse are vacant & it has become difficult to carry on day to day working of the Hospital, in view of which it was decided that Writ petitioners of SWP 2532/2016 titled "Nancy Kumari & Others v/s State & Others" may continue in view of court direction dated: 01-12-2016 till the disposal of said writ petition & simultaneously also appoint petitioners of petition No. 1868/2017 and 1625/2017, who have been selected against different set of vacancies of Jr. Staff by SSB;

Whereas, after perusing the select list, it was observed that recommendation in case of Vijay Mala 09/SC and Aziya Waseem Bhatti 02/RBA were withheld for want of fulfillment of certain deficiencies. The recommendation withheld were released later on by SSB and were endorsed to this office by the Administrative Department ^{Writ} Communication No: ME/NG/44/2012 dated: 20-04-2017 and ME/NG/44/2012 dated: 20-06-2017;

Whereas the plea of the candidates were examined with reference to select list and it was observed that they have been selected against the reserved category Post;

Now therefore, Sanction is hereby accorded to the appointment of following candidates as Jr. Staff Nurses in Govt. Medical College & Associated Hospitals, Jammu (Division Cadre Jammu) in the pay scale of 4000-6000 *pre-revised* (5200-20200+2400 *revised*).

The appointee (s) shall report to the Office of the Principal, Govt. Medical College, Jammu within a period of 21 days from the date of issuance of this Order. In case, the appointee fails to join the Department within the stipulated period of time, her appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled without any further notice. The appointee shall be allowed to join only on the production of the following documents/certificates in original.

- a) Academic/ Technical Qualification Certificate.
- b) Date of Birth Certificate.
- c) Health Certificate from the concerned Chief Medical Officer of the District.
- d) Permanent Resident Certificate.
- e) No Loan Certificate from the concerned District Industries Centre (DIC) and the District Employment and Counselling Department to the effect that no loan under self employment scheme has been taken by the appointee.
- f) Relevant Category Certificate (if any).
- g) Character Certificate from the concerned Police Station.

The appointment is subject to the following conditions:-

- I. The appointee(s) shall give an undertaking in the shape of an affidavit attested by 1st Class magistrate to the effect that in case, adverse report about his character and antecedents is received from the Inspector General of Police, CID J&K to whom a reference shall be made by the concerned, the candidate shall have no right to claim his/her appointment as Junior Staff Nurse and his/her appointment shall stand automatically deemed to have been cancelled ab-initio.
- II. If on verification, the certificates produced by the appointee proved to be fake or forged, the appointment shall stand as cancelled ab-initio.
- III. The interim arrangement, if any, made against the above posts on academic arrangement basis or on deputation basis shall be deemed to have been terminated forthwith.
- IV. The salary of the appointee shall be disbursed only on receipt of the verification report with regard to her character & antecedents and verification of documents and testimonials i.e Academic, Technical and Category from the verifying agency.






- V. The appointment of the said candidate shall be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" as per SRO 400 of 2009 dated: 24-12-2009.
- VI. The inter-se-seniority of the appointee(s) shall be in order of merit furnished by J&K Service Selection Board which shall be notified separately.
- VII. The appointment in Divisional Cadre is not transferable from one Division to another and change of Cadre is not acceptable.

The appointee (s) shall be initially on probation for a period of two years, and confirmation in the service shall be regulated under the provisions of the J&K Civil Services (Classification Control and Appeal Rules) 1956.

The appointment of the selected candidates is subject to the outcome of writ petition bearing SWP.No. 2532/2016 titled" Nancy Kumari Bhat & Ors. v/s State & Ors.
